1. **Important Dates and Deadline**

Mid-February – Summer 2021 courses available on Course Search & Enroll

March 28 – Summer term enrollment appointment times assigned to students throughout this week

April 4 – Students begin enrolling for Summer 2022 term courses according to appointment times

3. **Data Science Major Courses**

At this time, the following Data Science major course courses are planned to be offered during Summer 2022:

STAT 240 Introduction to Data Modeling I

COMP SCI 220 Data Programming I or COMP SCI 300 Programming II

L I S 461 Data and Algorithms: Ethics and Policy, both 3 credit non-Comm B and 4 credit Comm B sections are available and count towards foundation requirements

Additional courses to consider might include foundational Math classes (MATH 221, MATH 222) or upper-level electives offered from a variety of departments such as COMP SCI 400, 524, 525, 532, 539, 540, 564, 577, MATH 320, 340, 341, 431, 632, ECON 315, 410, E C E 203, I SY E 512, 575– this list is not exhaustive so please check for other courses that may be taught.
