Hi DS students,

Here's a few tips and tricks to help smooth the fall enrollment process:

- Review our **enrollment newsletter** (attached & on our website's "Planning your DS Major" section, expand option 1 "Future Semester Enrollment Information" and open the PDF).
- Check for your **enrollment appointment time** in your MyUW Student Center (and @wisc.edu email inbox).
- Check and **clear any holds** on your student account ([directions here](#)).
 - How to clear a hold? [This webpage](#) has information on the types of account holds, how it impacts you (i.e. no enrollment activity), and how to clear them.
- **Revalidate** your courses in Course Search & Enroll and **take action of any validation error messages**.
 - Still receiving a validation error message?
 - Try removing the course from your cart then readding it should fix.
 - Didn't work? You probably do not meet the course or section level prerequisites and/or the course is restricted to a certain student population.
- **Priority enrollment does not** guarantee access to certificate courses, but it allows declared certificate students to enroll before non-declared students.
 - Data Science certificate students currently have priority enrollment for L I S 461, STAT 340, and COMP SCI 320.
- **Issues with enrollment?** Email dsmajor@stat.wisc.edu or consult the following enrollment FAQ's.

Notes:

- Yes, certain classes are filling up quickly (for example, STAT 436). At your appointment time, add yourself to the waitlist (as available) and enroll in an alternative course to help make progression towards major requirements. Make sure to check prerequisites to make sure you're eligible for enrollment.
- Lastly, if you are graduating December 2024, please apply for graduation! This helps enrollment managers with course wait lists & priority enrollment access. Instructions can be found here: <https://registrar.wisc.edu/applyforgraduation/>.
